- Full access to electricity

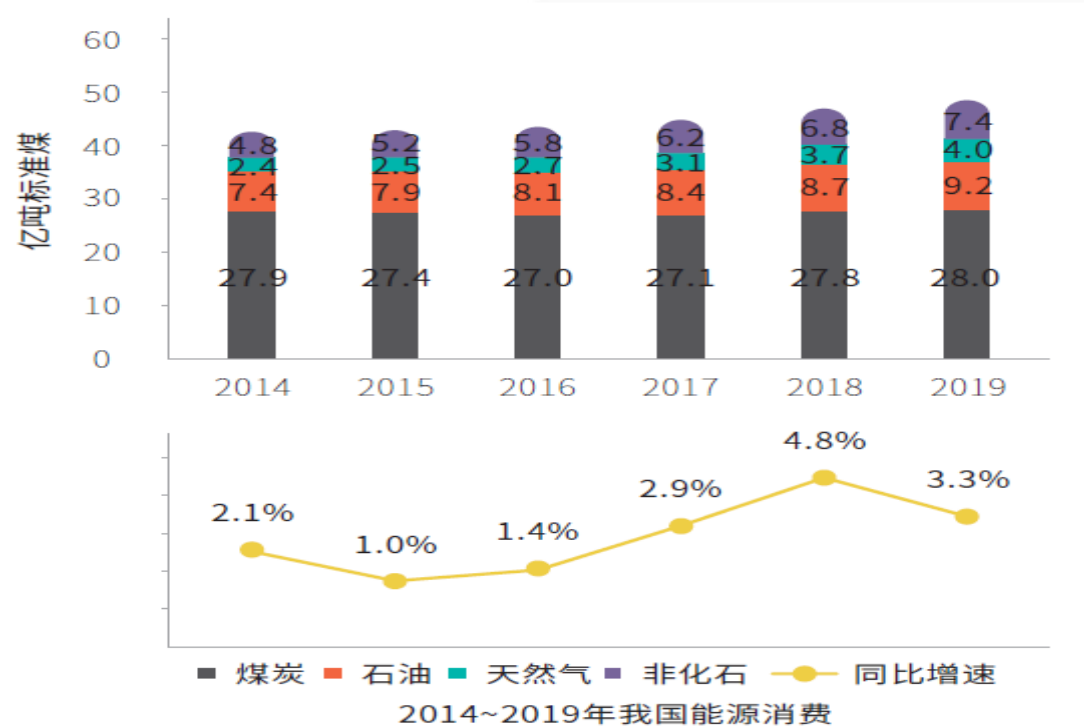
# Improving overall efficiency of energy governance

- Strengthen of regulation and supervision



# Energy Fundamentals in 2019

- Total energy consumption equal to 4.86 billion tons of standard coal
- Electricity consumption over 7 trillion kilowatt-hours
- Installed power generation capacity reached 2 billion kilowatts, non-fossil accounting 40%
